Authorship Regulations

- A free paper/ poster podium can have one presenting author and up to 3 co-authors (a total of 4 authors).
- Any of these 4 authors can serve as the presenting author.
- Each member may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts as the presenting author in both free paper and poster podium categories



Membership Requirements

- The presenting author and all co-authors must be members of BOS (either ratified or non-ratified).
- Non-member ophthalmic authors must register as BOS members to qualify as presenting authors or co-authors. Registration can be completed at <https://bangaloreophthalmicsociety.com/become-bos-member/>

Free Paper Presentation & Awards

- Free Paper/case presentation Duration: 5 minutes per presentation.
- E-Poster Podium: 3 min/ presentation
- Free Paper/ Poster Podium awards will be granted to the presenting author, with certificates awarded accordingly
- To be eligible for a BOS Award, the presenting author must be a BOS member.
- Papers presented at other conferences may be eligible for BOS Awards.

Abstract Guidelines

- **The free paper /case presentation abstract has to be structured (word limit- 1000 words)**
- Aim and Objectives, Method, Results, Conclusion

E-Poster podium abstract can be an unstructured abstract of max 500 words
Abstracts are accepted under the following specialities: Cataract and Refractive surgery, Uvea and Retina, Glaucoma, Trauma and Oculoplasty, cornea and Ocular surface, Comprehensive Ophthalmology, etc.
(One or more specialities may be combined depending on the number of submissions in the speciality)

Free papers/case presentation are accepted in any of the following specialities

Cataract, Community / Social Ophthalmology, Comprehensive Ophthalmology, Cornea, Diabetic Retinopathy and Medical Retina, External Eye & Ocular Surface Disease, Glaucoma, Neuro Ophthalmology, Ocular Pathology, Ocular Oncology and Tumors, Optics / Refraction / Contact Lens, Orbit & Oculoplasty, Pediatric Ophthalmology, Refractive Surgery, Squint, Trauma, Uvea
